Individual ID with leg or wing bands. Must be accompanied by a certificate or test chart to show that they originated from a hatchery or breeding flock that is classified pullorum-Typhoid clean or are negative to Pullorum-Typhoid test prior to the opening date of exhibition.

#### **Turkeys**

Individual ID with leg or wing bands. Must be accompanied by a certificate or test chart to show that they originated from a hatchery or breeding flock that is classified pullorum-Typhoid clean or are negative to Pullorum-Typhoid test prior to the opening date of exhibition.

No testing requirements. Individual ID with leg or wing bands
